Countries collide at Auctionata's Need for Speed sale

Set to take place on 11 June, Auctionata's Need for Speed sale looks like a showdown between Italy and Germany – something we could potentially see on the football pitch in the forthcoming European Championship in France...

The 27-lot catalogue for Auctionata's online Need for Speed sale predominantly features classic and modern Ferraris and Porsches, though there are two Mercedes', a Lancia and two speedboats thrown in for good measure. Admitedly, the selection of machines from Maranello is more diverse than those from Stuttgart, ranging from a <u>1978 400</u> to a stealthy <u>2014 458 Speciale</u>.





Of the Porsches offered, our pick would be the silver <u>1977 930</u> 'Turbo' that was treated to a sympathetic restoration by its last Swiss owner, earning it the coveted – and extremely hard-to-come-by – 'Veteran' status in Switzerland. It's estimated to fetch 220,000 euros. Also batting for Germany, the <u>1988 Mercedes-Benz 560 SL</u> looks a potential snip at 36,000 euros, given its condition. We'd have a hard job choosing between two Prancing Horses – do we go classic with the fabulous <u>1980 Ferrari 512BB</u> (est. 400,000 euros) or modern with the rare <u>2009 430</u> <u>Scuderia Spider 16M</u>, estimated at 340,000 euros?
